Dunedin Summer School 2014

A Dunedin, New Zealand, city scholarship programme hosted by Otago Polytechnic, University of Otago, and Dunedin High Schools

To acknowledge the long-standing Sister City relationship between Shanghai and Dunedin, and to foster educational collaboration between the two cities, students from Shanghai are invited to participate in a two-week study abroad programme offered in Dunedin in 2014.

A programme will be run from 8 to 21 January for our tertiary education partner institutions, and from 2 to 15 March for our secondary education partner institutions.

The study abroad scholarship is for:

- 12 students studying at tertiary level and an accompanying lecturer,
- 12 secondary school students and an accompanying teacher.

The scholarship covers insurance, accommodation, living and tuition costs while in Dunedin. Travel costs are not included as part of the scholarship.

Eligibility for the programme

Students who have demonstrated academic excellence and are recommended by partner institutions of Otago Polytechnic, the University of Otago, Kaikorai Valley College, Logan Park High School, Kavanagh College, Otago Boys' High School, and Otago Girls' High School.

Students studying at tertiary level will be over 18 years old, and secondary school students will be between 13 – 18 years old.

Courses and activities

The Dunedin Summer School provides classes and activities in English about New Zealand. Students will gain insights into New Zealand culture, history and lifestyle.

Please see the schedule below.

Accommodation

Students will stay with New Zealand families, and will be provided with three meals a day.

Airport pick-up

Students will be picked up from Dunedin International Airport and taken to their host family.
