2022 Admissions Guide for International Students

Shanghai Institute of Technology (SIT) is a high-level innovation and application-oriented university under Shanghai Municipality, dedicated to cultivating innovative, application-oriented engineering and technological talents with international vision. SIT was selected as one of the 100 national Application-oriented Demonstration Undergraduate Colleges and Universities in China, the first batch of first-class Undergraduate Construction Leading Plan of Shanghai Colleges and Universities, the first batch of first-class Postgraduate Education Leading Plan, the first batch of Demonstration Colleges and Universities in Shanghai to Deepen the Reform of Innovation and Entrepreneurship Education, the National Intellectual Property Pilot Colleges and Universities, the Shanghai Patent Work Demonstration Unit, and the Shanghai Model School of Governing School by Law. Since 2018, it has ranked first in the classified evaluation (applied technology type) of colleges and universities in Shanghai for four consecutive years. In 2021, SIT became a doctoral degree awarding unit and was approved as a key construction unit of high-level local universities in Shanghai.

School of Railway Transportation (SRT), the secondary colleges of SIT, was established in 2009. Focusing on high-speed railway and urban rail transit technology, the SRT maintains its complementary development and industry specialties, and cultivates high-level application-oriented engineering and technical personnel with international vision. The school is a member of the Belt and Road Initiative Railway Alliance Standing Committee and a member of the Shanghai Railway Society Standing Committee.

At present, SRT has five undergraduate programs, including Railway Engineering, Mechanical Design Manufacture and Automation (Vehicle Engineering), Communication Engineering (Railway Signaling Technology), Electrical Engineering and Automation (Electric Railway Traction), Transportation Engineering (Railway Transportation Management), and five master programs, which are Control Science and Engineering, Vehicle Engineering, Transportation, Electronic and Information Engineering, Resources and Environment.

SRT has a well-functioning professional laboratory for rail transit. At present, there are two provincial platforms, including *Joint International Research Laboratory of Shanghai Belt and Road China-Laos Railway Engineering* and *Shang Rail Transit Operation and Safety Experimental Teaching Demonstration Center*, and two school-level practical teaching bases as well, including *Rail Transit Service Equipment Safety Monitoring and Control Engineering Center* and *Rail Transit Comprehensive Practice Base*.

Students from all over the world are warmly welcome to apply to SRT of SIT.

I. ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

For Undergraduates:

Meet one of the following conditions:

- (1) Applicants must be a citizen of a country other than the People's Republic of China in good health with high school diploma and have university application qualification;
- (2) Applicants must be a citizen of a country other than the People's Republic of China in good health in freshman or sophomore year in college;
- (3) Applicants who immigrate to foreign countries from Chinese Mainland, Hong Kong, Macao or Taiwan, must have resided abroad for more than 2 years in the last 4 years, subject to the Exit-Entry Certification.

For Postgraduates:

One of the following conditions is requested:

- (1) Applicants must be a citizen of a country other than the People's Republic of China, in good health and have bachelor degree or above and Graduate application qualification.
- (2) Applicants who immigrate to foreign countries from Chinese Mainland, Hong Kong, Macao and Taiwan, as international students, must have actually resided abroad for more than 2 years in the last 4 years, subject to the Exit-Entry Certification.

(2) Offline application:

The application documents can be submitted by yourself or someone else, or mailed to SRT or International Cooperation Division of SIT, (please refer to Contact Information for the address).

Deadline: June 30, 2022

III. APPLICATION DOCUMENTS

- (1) *Application Form for Admission of Foreign Students to SIT* with a recent photo of the applicant and signed by the applicant.
- (2) Copy of Passport, personal information page of ordinary passport (valid on and after December 30, 2022). Applicants in Chinese Mainland also need to provide the visa page or residence permit page.

- (3) Highest academic certificate. Fresh high school graduates should submit the original certificate of expected graduation issued by schools; and college students should submit the certificate of enrollment issued by schools.
- (4) Transcript of all courses in the highest level of education.
- (5) Copy of Hanyu Shuiping Kaoshi(HSK) certificate and transcript.
- (6) Two recommendation letters from associate professors or of higher ranks (required for graduate applicants).
- (7) Applicants who have immigrated from Chinese Mainland, Hong Kong, Macao and Taiwan and have acquired foreign nationality must submit a certificate of naturalization, a copy of passport entry and exit records in the last 4 years, or submit documents to prove having actually lived abroad for more than 2 years in the last 4 years.
- (8) Foreign applicants who are not immigrants from Chinese Mainland, Hong Kong, Macao and Taiwan, and have more than two years of living and studying experience in the Chinese Mainland, Hong Kong, Macao and Taiwan in the last four years, must submit a certificate to prove their foreign nationalities by birth.
- (9) Physical examination record for foreigner.
- (10) A certificate of no criminal record.

Notes:

- ✧ The documents mentioned in Articles 3 and 4 above must be originals or notarized copies. Fair translations of texts other than Chinese and English are also required.
- ✧ The "last 4 years" in Articles 7 and 8 above refers to the period from June 30, 2018 to June 30, 2022. Documents that can prove the applicant's academic ability and comprehensive quality, such as published research papers, patents, award certificates, admission letters from foreign universities for undergraduate or higher and the like, can be submitted together with the application.
- ✧ If necessary, supplementary materials will be required. The above documents will not be returned, regardless of acceptance or rejection .

(2) Requirements

(a) Chinese Language:

Undergraduates: HSK 4 (above 210points) or equivalent;

Postgraduates: HSK 5 (above 210 points) or finished Chinese-based undergraduate program.

(b) Age: Applicants for undergraduate programs shall be under the age of 25, while postgraduate applicants shall be under the age of 35 and 40 for master's and doctorate programs respectively.

(c) Excellent performance in all aspects.
